• After 2nd reading of the Psalter, Sessional Hymn in tone 1:

O Judge invisible, How art Thou made <u>vis</u>ible in the flesh? <u>How</u> dost Thou now draw near to be slain by lawless men, Condemning by Thy Passion our own condem<u>nation</u>? <u>Therefore</u> with one accord, O <u>Word</u>. We ascribe praise, majesty and glory to Thy <u>power</u>.

• After 3rd reading of the Psalter, Sessional Hymn in tone 8:

The first-fruits of the Lórd's Passion fill this present day with light. Come then, all who love to keep the feast, and let us welcome it with songs. For the Creator draws near to undergo the Cross; He is questioned, beaten, and brought to Pilate for judgement; A servant strikes Him on the face, and all this He endures that He may save mankind. Therefore let us cry aloud to Him: O Christ our God who lovest man, grant remission of sins to those who venerate in faith Thy Holy Passion.
